Photo Tips

1. Make sure all persons are wearing appropriate clothing, hard hats, glasses, and safety equipment such as harnesses.
2. Show equipment while it is in operation, not when it is idle.
3. Think about before, during and after shots that show the work as it was completed.
4. Show workers when they are working, not standing and watching someone else work.
5. Try to take close-up shots, if possible, of employees and equipment.
6. Focus on your workers, not others at any job site.
7. Consider non-job photos that help tell the story. If you are completing a job at a shopping center, take a photo of the entrance with the name of the center prominently displayed; for a job on an expressway, perhaps a shot of the interstate sign or exchange; or for a job at a location such as Sea World or Disney World, a photo of the main entrance to either theme park would add interest to your story.
8. Digital photos must be at least 300 dpi resolution.

What type of equipment:

Describe any special problems:

(You encountered on the job and how did you address those problems.)

Brief History of your company:

(Years in Business, number of trucks, number of employees, number of branch locations, types of services offered, specialty services, strengths of your company?)
